In June of 2022, Concordia Publishing House released "Continue: Poems and Prayers of Hope." The book debut as a #1 New Release on Amazon.

Tanner has spoken across the United States and beyond. He has delivered messages at churches, shared poetry in classrooms, coffeehouses, and living rooms, presented at conferences, and emceed events.

His writing has been described as unique as it blends faith, humor, and curiosity as he seeks to remind readers and listeners that hope is real and good is on the way.

Tanner grew up in Oviedo, Florida before attending Concordia University Wisconsin where he studied ministry and theology. HONORARIUM FEES & REQUIREMENTS

Honorarium cost varies due to presentation specifics, travel requirements, and required preparation.

Generally, \$2500 is the minimum for each event, and this includes travel, hotel, and food.

If you would like me to speak multiple times (i.e., three presentations over the course of a weekend), my typical honorarium fee starts at \$3500.

Please feel free to chat with me about your individual event. I can be flexible on fees and schedule, depending on your unique organization and expectations we can agree on.

PREPARATIONS

My speaking preparation includes a one-on-one conversation and/or email to talk through your event. If helpful, I am available to work with your event planning team for discussion and creative brainstorming.

Pre-Event Preparation:

To understand your needs and prepare relevant content, I will:

- Have at least one phone/email conversation to understand your event theme, audience, and desired outcomes.
- If necessary, attend pre-event phone call(s) with your event planning team to align presentation content.
- Together, we will draft a simple letter of agreement for my services. The honorarium will be paid in full according that agreement.
- Provide a speaker bio and session description for inclusion in your promotional material.
- If desired, I will provide an initial draft my presentation content for review. This must be requested no more than 60 days before the event start date.

In order to facilitate a smooth event, your organization will:

- Arrange travel and lodging accommodations (I often fly out of Nashville, TN BNA).
- Arrange transportation to and from the airport and event facility (or compensate for Uber/Lyft/rental car).
- Ensure the room is set up and all required equipment is ready to go. If possible, please provide tech support to ensure that my presentation is smooth. This enables a quality experience for your audience.

On-Site Specifics:

- I will deliver a presentation at your event on the scheduled date and time(s) detailed in our arrangements.
- I will attend key event sessions you'd like me to be present at and network with your organization's audience members.
- I can attend any ancillary events, like dinners or receptions or host Q&A sessions, at your request. We can discuss specific on-site expectations during our pre-event planning call(s).

Any other needs will be identified in our pre-event planning discussions.

Speaking Needs:

- Music stand or podium for notes.
- Hands free microphone (lapel or over the ear) or mic on a stand.
- Wi-Fi
- Folding table to sell books and other merchandise.
